

Updated Resident and Guest Guidelines

Out-of-State Travel

Effective Monday, March 1, 2021, Pennsylvania's Gov. Tom Wolf lifted the "out-of-state" travel restrictions that have been imposed since November 2020. Therefore, guests traveling to PA from other states (or PA residents returning home from other states) do not need to produce evidence of a negative COVID-19 test in order to enter PA or quarantine before or after travels.

Children on Campus

Effective immediately, children are permitted on Willow Valley Communities Campuses with the following protocols for safety and well-being:

- Children over the age of 2 are required to wear a mask
- Similar to adult visitors, children are only permitted in a loved one's apartment or patio/balcony (Guests are not permitted in common areas such as lobbies, library, courtyards etc.)
- Social distancing must be maintained
- Proper hand washing must be maintained

Pets on Campus

No change is being made to the restriction of visitor pets on Campus at this time.

International Travel

Residents and Guests travelling internationally are still required to produce evidence of a negative SARS-COV2 (COVID-19) test from a specimen collected within 72 hours prior to entering the Commonwealth, or quarantine for 14 days upon entering.
