

Dining Information for Thanksgiving

Thanksgiving is Thursday, November 25. While we are unable to welcome family and friends in our dining rooms, we would like to make you aware of some options should you choose to dine with us, plan to pick up meals or would like to entertain a small group of family members in your apartment.

Dining in the Community Dining Rooms

- If you are planning on dining in the Manor, Lakes, or North dining room, please let us know by filling out a simple form that can be found at the host stations in each community. Please note that this is **not a reservation** but it will help us best plan for the number of Residents planning to dine with us. In an effort to minimize wait times, we will be open for the noon meal from 11:30 AM until 2:00 PM and advise that you consider dining earlier or later in that time period.
- If you would like to purchase additional To-Go meals for your guests (maximum of 5 meals), please pick up guest meal menus located at the host stations in the community you wish to dine. Have your guests select their menu and bring it with you to the dining room on Thanksgiving Day. Our culinary team will fill your guest orders at that time.

Thanksgiving Meal Catered Option

Our Cultural Center Catering department will be preparing Thanksgiving meal basics (turkey, stuffing, mashed potatoes and gravy) for purchase and pick-up by Residents.
