Two Residents at Lakes have tested positive for COVID-19. The Residents, a married couple, are in isolation in their own apartment.

A Manor (building) Resident has tested positive for COVID-19. After experiencing symptoms, the Resident was taken to Penn Medicine/LGH Hospital, where a COVID-19 test was administered, resulting in a positive diagnosis. The Resident remains at the hospital.

Seven (7) Team Members have tested positive for COVID-19. The Team Members' departments, work locations, and most recent days worked at Willow Valley Communities are listed below.

- Team Member #1: Administration at Lakes; most recent day worked: 12/3
- Team Member #2: Housekeeping at North; most recent day worked: 12/1
- Team Member #3: Marketing & Sales; most recent day worked: 12/2
- Team Member #4: Nursing at Lakeside; most recent day worked: 12/4
- Team Member #5: Nursing at Meadow Ridge; most recent day worked: 12/5
- Team Member #6: Marketing & Sales; most recent day worked: 12/3
- Team Member #7: Culinary at Lakes; most recent day worked: 12/3

Willow Valley Communities is following protocols for contact with appropriate government agencies and is taking every step possible to limit further exposure. Willow Valley Communities implemented its contact tracing protocols to identify any known persons (Residents and/or Team Members) with whom the affected Residents or Team Members may have had exposure that requires additional risk mitigation.
