

COVID-19 Protocol Updates

The COVID-19 pandemic safety protocols have been a focus for all of us at Willow Valley Communities for two years. We are pleased to see infection case rates and hospitalization numbers continue to decrease. The improved metrics now allow for the much-anticipated safe return to more normal activities.

Effective Monday, March 14, 2022, amenities at Willow Valley Communities will be open to both Residents and Resident Guests, with very few exceptions that are noted on the attached list in orange print. Please note: If the infection metrics change within our WVC campuses or in the county, safety protocols will be reviewed and revised as needed.

Guidelines for Visitors to our Community

- Visitors will continue to stop at the guard station for screening
- Unvaccinated visitors are strongly encouraged to wear a mask while in public
- Visitors arriving from recent international travel are asked to follow current guidance based on their vaccination status

Independent Living Amenities are open to Residents and their Guests with the following exceptions:

- Culinary: Community dining rooms and Four Seasons will remain open to Residents only during breakfast and dinner. Limited "to go" meals are available for visitors.
- Cultural Center Evening Theater: Renaissance Evening Events remain open to <u>Residents only</u> and masks are required. Full opening is anticipated for the summer series.

Guidelines for Travel

- International
 - Vaccinated individuals
 - * Self-monitor for COVID-19 symptoms for 10 days
 - * Obtain a COVID-19 test within 3–5 days of their arrival in the US
 - * If symptoms develop, isolate and seek testing immediately
 - ◊ Unvaccinated individuals
 - * Quarantine and self-monitor for COVID-19 symptoms for 10 days, testing immediately with onset of symptoms
 - * If the individual remains asymptomatic and a COVID-19 test is obtained at 5–7 days after arrival in the US, quarantine may be reduced to 7 days
- Domestic
 - Asymptomatic individuals should self-monitor for COVID-19 symptoms for 10 days following travel
 - If symptoms develop, isolate and seek testing immediately

COVID-19 Booster Clinic: Stay "Up to Date" with your COVID-19 Vaccine

Research supports that that a booster dose of COVID-19 vaccine increases the immune response to provide improved protection against the COVID-19 virus.

Booster eligibility:

- Pfizer and Moderna recipients are eligible 5 months after completing the initial vaccine series
 - Immunocompromised individuals are eligible for second booster dose 3 months after the 3rd dose of vaccine
- J&J vaccine recipients are eligible 2 months after their primary dose of vaccine

Pfizer and Moderna vaccine will be available to Residents and Team Members at our upcoming vaccine clinics.
